The program is presented by the New Jersey chapter of the Community Associations Institute (CAI-NJ) and the New Jersey Legislative Action Committee (LAC).

This annual program focuses on a broad range of issues to New Jersey's common interest communities. The agenda will include an update of 2017 legislative topics, including board elections, delinquencies and expedited foreclosures, municipal bonding requirements, solar installations, insurance deductibles, security cameras and snow removal contractors. Ms. Li and her fellow speakers will also look ahead to the 2018-2020 legislative term with a discussion of key pending issues.

Ms. Li focuses her practice in real estate, with a concentration in planned real estate development law and condominium law.
