The Hon. Michael R. Casale (Ret.), Of Counsel in the firm's Family Law Department, will be a panelist for a program entitled "Cohabitation Law in a Developing Legal Landscape," to be presented on Thursday, June 21, 2018 at 6:00pm. In September 2014, New Jersey amended its alimony statute: N.J.S.A. 2A:34-23. One of the most important and far reaching changes of the new statute was in the area of cohabitation. Judge Casale and his fellow panelists will engage in a comprehensive discussion of this law: both pre and post-amendment. They will discuss their own experiences of how courts have addressed this topic, as well as what judges are now focusing on when this issue comes before them.
