Judge Kessler, Of Counsel in the firm’s Litigation and Family Law Departments, is a member of the Section.

The discussion agenda is as follows:

- Significant programs that arise from the lack of an operating agreement and default provisions to which attention in drafting agreements should be directed
- Enforcement of operating agreements as written and difficulty of amending agreements by course of conduct which is not clear
- Other programs that arise from drafting issues, including:
 - Oppression and dissolution
 - Fair value vs. no articulated standard and no case law
 - Nuclear option when operating agreement mandates dissolution and lawyer does not understand its meaning under NJ-RULLCA
 - How to address in an operating agreement

Judge Kessler focuses his practice on resolving commercial and family law disputes through mediation and arbitration as an alternative to traditional litigation.
