These include express duties set forth in contracts, statutes, and regulations, as well as the duties implied as a matter of law. The speakers will also discuss the claims and dispute resolution process, the elements of causes of action for breaches of express and implied duties, and whether such claims should be resolved by arbitration or a court of law.
