

Steven Nudelman Appointed to Third Term on New Jersey Supreme Court CDR Committee

Steven Nudelman, Chair of the firm's **Construction Contracting & Risk Management Practice Group** and a partner in the **Litigation Department**, has been appointed to a third consecutive term on the New Jersey Supreme Court Committee on Complementary Dispute Resolution (CDR) for its 2021-2023 term. The appointment is effective September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2023.

The Committee on CDR oversees and implements the rules governing the Supreme Court's CDR practice, which includes mediation, arbitration and settlement proceedings. The Committee evaluates these programs and the standards for selecting and training mediators and arbitrators. CDR programs are available to help parties resolve disputes in a variety of actions, including family law and matrimonial disputes, personal injury claims, landlord-tenant disputes and small claims matters. In addition, the Committee examines and makes recommendations to the Court regarding rules, policies and procedures governing the Court's arbitration program.

Mr. Nudelman concentrates his practice in construction law. His clients include owners, contractors, design professionals, subcontractors and suppliers involved in public and private construction projects throughout New Jersey. He also represents community associations, unit owners and developers in lawsuits involving construction defects, budgeting and financing issues, and condominium governance.
