Led by Greenbaum partner **Steven Nudelman**, who chairs our construction contracting & risk management practice, the firm served as construction contracting counsel for NJIT, advising the University on the Oak Hall project, guiding it through procurement, contract development, and negotiations with design-build partner Terminal Construction Corporation. The firm's team supported NJIT from the initial bid process through final contract and pricing arrangements, helping ensure the project moved forward efficiently and on sound contractual footing.

This work is part of the firm's broader role as redevelopment counsel to NJIT under the lead of partner **Steven G. Mlenak**, co-chair of our redevelopment & land use practice. In that role, the firm has advised the University on redevelopment initiatives totaling well over \$150 million. This work includes supporting NJIT in sourcing development partners, preparing joint venture and development agreements, rehabilitating a locally designated historic property for multifamily housing, and amending existing redevelopment plans and agreements.
