Established in 1958, ABOTA is an invitation-only organization of lawyers and judges who defend the civil justice system in the United States. Members must have at least five years of active experience as trial lawyers, have tried at least seven civil jury trials to conclusion and possess additional litigation experience. ABOTA's mission is to preserve the right to a trial by jury, as guaranteed by the Seventh Amendment of the Constitution. ABOTA membership consists of more than 7,300 plaintiff and defense lawyers and judges across 95 chapters in all 50 states and in the District of Columbia.

Shapiro's practice focuses on the defense of medical malpractice, hospital liability, long-term care facilities, professional liability, premises liability, and handling a diverse array of catastrophic personal injury claims.
