B. The Construction Industry Licensing Board is responsible for licensing and regulating the construction industry. The board meets regularly to consider application for licensure, to review disciplinary cases, and to conduct informal hearings relating to licensure and discipline in Florida. The board engages in rulemaking to implement the provisions set forth in its statutes and conducts other general business.
