Below is a representative sample of the types of services we provide clients in connection with ERISA, Disability and Leave Laws:

- ✓ We represent private sector clients, primarily in federal court, with respect to a variety of issues arising under the Employment Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"). These matters include withdrawal liability, multiemployer plan contribution disputes, benefit disputes, fiduciary obligations, including under Employer Stock Ownership Plans ("ESOP's"), Department of Labor and Fringe Benefit audits, and COBRA and HIPAA disputes.
- ✓ Representation of public and private sector clients before various governmental agencies, including the EEOC, Illinois Department of Human Rights, Illinois Human Rights Commission, Cook County Human Rights Commission and the Chicago Commission on Human Relations regarding leave entitlements and disability claims arising under the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Illinois Human Rights Act and other local ordinances. This includes the preparation of position statements and submission of responsive materials to the agency, as well as contested hearings.
