



hold your horses: california extends deadline for mandatory sexual harassment training

In 2018, California passed a law that greatly expanded sexual harassment training requirements for employers (see [here](#)). Under the law, employers of as few as five people must provide two hours of interactive sexual harassment training to their supervisors and one hour to all non-supervisory employees. The training was to have been completed by January 1, 2020.

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
