Robert Rotstein was quoted in *Home Media Magazine* about the copyright infringement lawsuit filed by the Motion Picture Association of America (MPAA) against movie-streaming website Zediva.com. "The first-sale doctrine protects the use of the physical good, but it doesn't allow for public performance," Rotstein said. "Even if they have a limited number of DVDs, under the law it's still public performance."
