"Copyright law gives a lot of very broad rights to make use of the original expression that someone created," Eleanor M. Lackman, a Mitchell Silberberg & Knupp LLP partner, told *Law360*, adding that "in general, fan fiction is more likely to be seen as problematic if it's highly similar to the original, and it's commercial."
