## The Anti-Indemnity Train Continues

Amundsen Davis Transportation Alert January 15, 2016

On December 22, 2015, Ohio became the latest and 43<sup>rd</sup> state to adopt an antiindemnification provision for transportation agreements. Effective March 21, 2016, the bill voids any section of a transportation contract that indemnifies the promisee from liability when the loss was caused by the promisee's actions. This statute does not apply to the UIIA.
