The Davis-Bacon and Related Acts (DBRA) is the federal prevailing wage law that applies directly to contractors and subcontractors working on federally funded or assisted construction contracts in excess of \$2,000. The U.S. Department of Labor has not updated its substantive rulemaking interpreting, administering and enforcing the law in several decades.
