

Awarded Summary Judgment in Federal Court Finding Insurer Had No Duty to Defend Wrongful Death Lawsuit Arising out of Real Estate Transaction Coverage Dispute

Erika Stamper won summary judgment on behalf her insurer client in Indiana federal court. The court found that the insurer had no duty to defend a wrongful death lawsuit against a real estate company arising from an alleged failure to properly list a home as a rental. The court held that allegations against insured did not constitute an “occurrence” or a “personal and advertising injury.”
