

Secured Dismissal With Prejudice in COVID-19 Vaccine Mandate Religious Exemption Case

Amundsen Davis secured dismissal of a lawsuit against a long-term senior living facility. The Plaintiff alleged that her employer forced her to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, violating her claimed religious beliefs under Title VII and the Illinois Health Care Right of Conscience Act. The case was dismissed with prejudice.
