

Moses Suarez Sworn in as First Latino president of the Lesbian and Gay Bar Association of Chicago

SA's Moses Suarez has been elected the first Latino president of the Lesbian and Gay Bar Association of Chicago (LAGBAC). His term commenced on October 1, 2018. Moses has served as vice president of LAGBAC since 2015 and on its board of directors since 2010.
