

Illinois' New Paid Leave Mandate Impacting All Manufacturing Workers

The new Paid Leave for All Workers Act (the "Act") will take effect on January 1, 2024, and will require Illinois employers to offer a minimum of 40 hours of paid leave to every employee for a 12-month period. While there is time to get ready, it is important for manufacturing employers to start preparing now by checking their current policies and understanding the Act's purpose.
