Katy Ross Discusses FAA's August Deadline for Unmanned Aircraft Systems Rule

Katy M. Ross, an associate in Wiley Rein's Communications Practice, was quoted in a *Law360* article published yesterday about a report by the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) inspector general which said the agency will probably not issue a final rule on small unmanned aircraft systems by its August deadline.
