David Weslow Discusses ICANN's Uniform Rapid Suspension System

David E. Weslow, a partner in Wiley Rein's Intellectual Property Practice, was quoted today by *Bloomberg BNA*'s *Electronic Commerce & Law Report*, in an article about the Uniform Rapid Suspension System (URS), a new dispute resolution procedure that is mandatory for all new generic top-level domains (gTLDs) such as . clothing, .email, and .xyz.

The URS provides trademark owners with a faster, less costly path to obtain the disabling of domain names in clear-cut cases of cybersquatting.

Mr. Weslow filed one of the earliest cases under the URS and discussed with *Bloomberg BNA* the burden of proof under the URS and other strategic considerations for trademark owners when considering a URS proceeding or other type of anti-cybersquatting action.
