Caleb Burns Comments on Gov. Pence Being Named as Trump's Running Mate

Caleb P. Burns, a partner in Wiley Rein's Election Law & Government Ethics Practice, was quoted in a July 15 *FoxNews.com* article on presumptive Republican presidential nominee Donald Trump naming Indiana Gov. Mike Pence as his vice-presidential running mate. New Jersey Gov. Chris Christie and former House Speaker Newt Gingrich were also being considered for the position.

"Pence is a through-and-through conservative," said Mr. Burns, adding Gov. Pence could "energize the workhorses of the party."
