Wiley Named an “Enduring Influence” by *The National Law Journal*

Washington, DC—*The National Law Journal* has recognized Wiley Rein & Fielding Managing Partner Richard E. Wiley as an enduring influence in the practice of law.

In 1985, *The National Law Journal* began publishing its "Profiles in Power," naming 100 "men and women who stand out from the crowd as this country's most powerful lawyers" in "their ability to wield force, authority, or influence."
