## Wiley Files Amicus Brief Fourth Circuit Case Concerning Limits on Judicial Authority

## June 25, 2025

Wiley, along with the Liberty Justice Center, has filed an amicus brief in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit in Jonathan R. v. Morrisey, arguing that the court should affirm the dismissal of a lawsuit in light of inherent limits on the Judicial Branch's constitutional authority.
