Wiley Named NLJ Litigation Department of the Year Finalist

Wiley's Litigation Practice has been named a 2025 finalist for Litigation Department of the Year by *The National Law Journal* in the "General Litigation" category.

The firm was shortlisted for this prestigious award in recognition of its work successfully guiding clients through multidisciplinary, high-stakes litigation, including:

- Securing a first-of-its-kind victory and millions of dollars in damages in a trademark infringement and counterfeiting lawsuit based on a massive international robocall scam;
- Persuading the U.S. Supreme Court to unanimously reject, in a precedent-setting case, an attempt by the state of Georgia to prosecute Wiley's client a second time for the same offense; and
- Appealing and securing the reversal of a series of lower court rulings exempting certain foreign goods from antidumping and countervailing duty orders on aluminum extrusions from China.

The Litigation Practice is consistently ranked by *Chambers USA* and *Benchmark Litigation*, and was named an "Intimidating Opponent" by BTI Consulting in 2025.

The winners will be announced on November 5 at the National Law Journal Legal Awards event in Washington, D.C.
