Wiley Ranks No. 3 in *Washington Business Journal's* 2020 'Corporate Philanthropy' List of Midsize Companies in DC

Washington, DC – Wiley earned a top spot on *Washington Business Journal's* "Corporate Philanthropy" list for Midsize Companies – as measured by DC metro-area giving – for the sixth year in a row.
