FCC Publishes Repeal of Radio Duplication Rule

October 28, 2020

As we have previously described, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC or Commission) recently adopted an Order eliminating the so-called radio duplication rule, which prohibited more than 25% duplication of programming on commonly-owned stations operating in the same service with certain overlapping principal community contours.

The Order was published in the *Federal Register* on October 22, 2020, which means repeal of the rule (47 C.F.R. § 73.3556) became effective as of that date.
